

AUTOSIT WHEN STOPPING

Teaching your dog to stop moving when
you do



Dog will autosit when person walking dog stops moving

Pre-req: Your dog sits on verbal and hand signal cues.

STEP	WHAT TO DO
1	Dog on leash. Walk for a few steps, stop moving, cue your dog to sit with verbal then hand signal, if needed, and reward. Repeat 10 times
2	Walk for a few steps, stop moving, give dog up to 10 seconds to sit without cueing. Cue if dog doesn't sit within those 10 seconds. Reward.
3	Walk for a few steps, stop moving. Give dog infinite latency to sit without cue. Reward with bonus when it happens.
4	Walk for a few steps, stop moving. Give dog infinite latency to sit without cue. Reward with bonus if it happens immediately. Reward with lower value if it takes a while. Repeat this step until dog is autositting immediately when you stop moving.
5	Repeat step 4 but Increase number of steps before stopping.
6	Repeat step 4 but increase distractions like busier road, traffic, people, dogs, stroller.
